Susanna Fiennes - Thursday 4th February 2010. One day £65.

Susanna graduated from the Slade School of Fine Art, London, in 1983. She has had many exhibitions and commissions and teaches life drawing classes in London. Susanna is coming with her model for the day to teach life drawing.

Amanda Butler – Wednesday & Thursday 24th & 25th February 2010. Two days £120.

Amanda studied classical drawing and portraiture at the Studio Simi in Florence (1980) and pastel work with the Warwickshire artist Betty Bowman. She also teaches oils. Amanda has run a very successful art group from her home for the past 20 years. She is here to teach still life in mixed medium.

Both courses start at 10am but it's best to be here by 9.30am to set up and have a cup of coffee before the course starts. A light lunch with a well earned glass of wine will be provided and tea and coffee will be available all day. The day ends at about 4pm.

You will need to bring your own paints, boards etc., and an easel if you don't want to work from a table.

A deposit of £40 is required on booking and the balance should be paid on arrival. On this basis we need a minimum of 10 people per course and if this number isn't achieved within 2 weeks of the start date, the course will be cancelled and all monies paid refunded.

From Plot to Plate - Thursday 11th March 2010 12.30pm to 4.30pm. Afternoon £55.
